I also type 200 words a minute without ever looking at the computer keyboard, create, and mass produce my own flyers, brochures, and power point slides, and I am an inventor. I am an associate teacher in early childhood education and I also received my assistant teacher permit from the California state commission of teacher credentialing. For this reason, I am serious for student success since I am a license preschool teacher in the state of California. I was elected to the Bakersfield city school district in 2018. I also had second job interview with united states department of homeland security in 2017. I also had two recommendations from three civil rights attorney that I can ace the state, federal, and international bar exam without ever stepping into law school. I was accepted in the honor program at American river college for the paralegal, psychology, and mechatronics programs. I also was accepted into Sacramento city college honor program for the administration of justice programs, sociology, and political science programs. I was also in Sacramento city college associated student government from the year 2008-2014 as a student senator and commissioner environmental affairs which I lead my own committee, and I was the Sacramento city college secretary of public relations for the student government at Sacramento city college, and I am the current director of public relations for the clubs and events board at American river college, and In 2010, I was on the ballot for the sacramento city college homecoming king, and I won the election, for this reason I have experience in student advocacy and who have experience in the county election system too.
