The 2024-2025 FAFSA and CADAA applications are now open for scholars seeking financial aid for next year. FAFSA is currently in a soft launch period but will remain open until May 2, 2025 at 11:59 p.m. Central Time. The California financial aid priority deadline is May 2, 2024. Correction Period will be rolling out in April.

### How To Correct or Update Your FAFSA® Form:

Most of the questions on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®) form want to know your situation as of the day you sign the application. However, there are some instances in which you'll want to (or be required to) change the information you reported.
