

BOARD OF DIRECTORS ELIGIBILITY AND VERIFICATION POLICY

Approved by the Board of Directors October 15, 2022

The Student Senate for California Community Colleges (SSCCC) Board of Directors and Region Officers shall continuously meet the requirements specified in Education Code 76061 to be eligible to serve on either the SSCCC Board of Directors or Region Board. A student who is elected as a Board Officer, Director, or Region Officer of the SSCCC shall meet one of the following requirements.

(a) (1) The student shall be enrolled in the community college at the time of election, and throughout the student's term, with a minimum of five semester units, or the quarter units.

(2) The student shall meet and maintain the minimum standards of scholarship prescribed for community college students by the community college district.

(i) A Region Officer must maintain a minimum of five semester units in the same region in which they serve

(b) The student shall be enrolled in an adult education program offered by a community college district pursuant to Article 9 (commencing with Section 84900) of Chapter 5 of Part 50, at the time of the election and throughout the student's term.

(c) The student is enrolled in the community college at the time of election, and throughout the student's term, and is a disabled student, as defined in subdivision (b) of Section 84850.

The policy outlined in AP #1005 will guide the verification process of the SSCCC.
