

UC Davis Menstrual Product Needs and Usage Survey

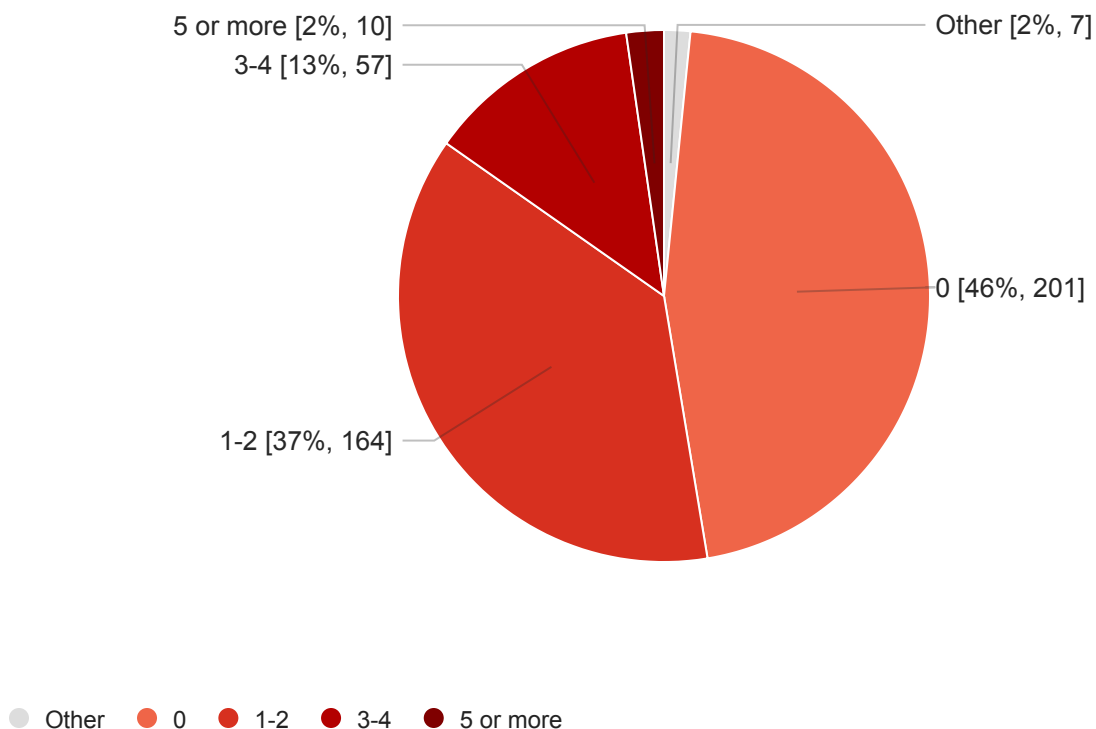
This survey was conducted starting in May 2018 through March 2020, and garnered a total of 483 responses. It publicized to the UC Davis general community and received responses from undergraduate and graduate students, faculty and staff, and other members of the UC Davis community.

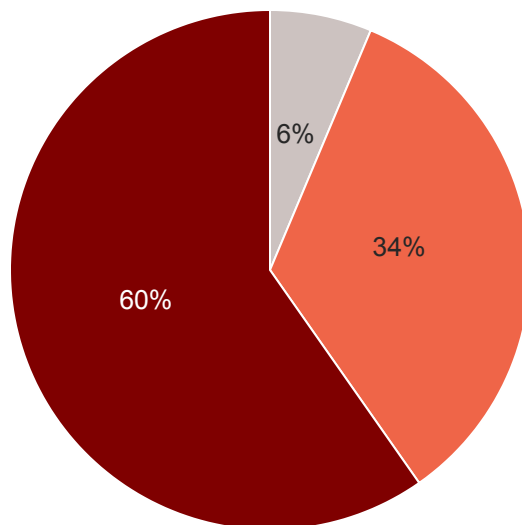
NOTE: all questions were voluntary and some respondents did not answer all questions, the number of responses per question is noted in parentheses after each question title.

(442 question responses)



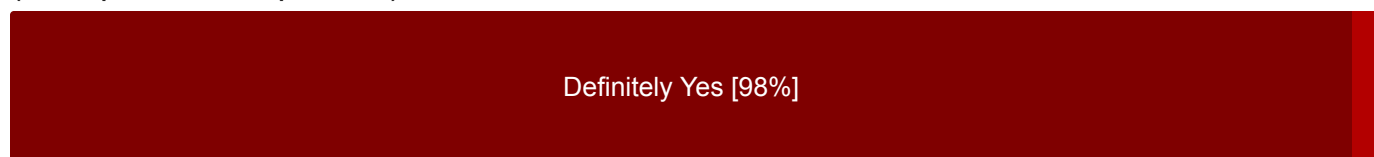
