Candidates for SSCCC Board Officer positions are required to submit a biographical statement. Please use the format below and provide the responses to the following questions. Please ensure that this statement is structured in the required format and the statement must be limited to one side of one 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 11 sheet of white paper.

PLEASE SUBMIT:

- 1. A **one-page** biography with your name, college, candidate position and the following information:
 - a. After reviewing the job description for the position, what student activities and special skills qualify you for the position and why are you running for this position?
 - b. What statewide issues are you most interested in or most concerned about and why?
 - c. What would your first three priorities be if you are elected and why?

FAQs

Candidate statements

- cannot contain slander or derogatory comments about other candidates or individuals.
- can include endorsements (see <u>Elections Procedure</u> VII, Section 1.g.).
- can include pictures.
- can be in any font size but must be readable.

Your biography statement will be published in the Candidate Booklet and posted on the SSCCC website and distributed on the first day of the SSCCC General Assembly. We highly suggest that **you check for typos and other errors** as the statement will be inserted into the booklet as received.
