#### C. Adoption of the Agenda | 5 mins.

No amendments were made and the agenda was approved without objections.

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## D. Public Comment

Public comment was heard.

Motioned, seconded, (LAD IX Vallesteros) no objections to appoint RAD VIII Kieviet to chair the meeting. Yes - 12, No - 5 (VPC Campos, RAD Region II Galinato, LAD Region III Villalobos, RAD Region X Laila, and RAD Region X). The motion passed and RAD Region VIII Kieviet will chair the meeting.

# II. BUSINESS

## A. Board Member Concerns

SSCCC's legal counsel Mark Alcorn provided an overview of his role as legal counsel, the fiduciary duties of SSCCC members, and his length of service to the SSCCC. He then provided background about a recent complaint received by the California community college against the SSCCC President and the organization's executive director. Mr. Alcorn presented the following resolution with a series of actions he recommended the Board consider.

Be it resolved, that the Board of Directors authorizes legal counsel to analyze legal issues raised in correspondence from the California community colleges Chancellor's Office to this corporation dated September 29, 2021, and the charges set forth in the correspondence from Jasmine Prasad to Gerardo Chavez dated October 2, 2021, and advise the board concerning them, and be it further

Resolved, that the Board of Directors directs legal counsel to contact the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office concerning whether or not it will intervene in or investigate the matters described in the documents set forth above, and be it further

Resolved, that the Board of Directors authorizes legal counsel to engage an impartial third party investigator to investigate the facts related to the allegations, and to report those findings to the board in a open board meeting to the extent required by the Brown Act, and be if further

Resolved, that the Board of Directors authorizes expenditures not to exceed \$15,000 for independent investigative services, and be it further,

Resolved, that directors are hereby directed not to discuss this matter outside of a board meeting <u>including in their regions and with the public</u> <u>including but not limited to</u> email, text, voice, or social media, other than

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making statements as required by law, or to the investigator designated by legal counsel, or to legal counsel.

Motioned, seconded, (RAD Region I Hill) to adopt the fourth resolved that no more than \$15,000 be spent to hire an impartial third party investigator. No objections. Yes - 18, No - 0. The motion passed. The SSCCC will spend no more than \$15,000 on an investigator for this process.

Motioned, seconded, (RAD Region VII Medina) to adopt the remaining resolved including 1, 2, 3, and 5. No objections. Yes - 17, No - 0, NVR - 1 (Kenneth Vallesteros). The motion passed and the resolution was passed as amended.

Motioned, seconded, (RAD Region II Galinato) to insert "including in their regions and with the public via email, text, voice, or social media" in the resolution final resolved. Yes - 18, No - 0. The motion passed and the final resolved was amended.

Motioned, seconded, (RAD Region X Laila) to insert "but not limited to" after including in the final resolved. Yes - 18, No - 0.
