

### Sierra College Advanced EMT Students Pilot Statewide Scope of Practice

Sierra College, located in Rocklin, California and educates approximately 16,000 students each year is one of the 14 colleges in Region II. One of their most popular CTE pathways on campus is their Health Sciences. This includes a variety of career focused programs such as Emergency Medical Technician (EMT), Advanced Emergency Medical Technician (AEMT), and Paramedic. Currently there are approximately 400 students enrolled in this three programs alone.



In November, Sacramento County announced the first and only pilot program of its kind, in which AEMTs will be testing out and expanded scope of practice for interfacility transfer (IFT) patients for one year. A scope of practice dictates the procedures and tools EMS workers may use in the field. California currently does not have a scope of practice for their AEMTs. This scope of practice will include a variety of life saving medications and diagnostic techniques previously only permitted for use by paramedics. If this pilot program is successful, the scope of practice will be applied to not only IFTs but also emergency calls. Sierra College is the only community college in the state of California and one of two locations in the state currently training AEMTs. This gives the students of Sierra College an incredible opportunity to open up my opportunities and create change for the future of California's EMS system.
