The Student Senate for California Community Colleges (SSCCC) is the official voice of California's two million community college students. Our mission is to enrich the collegiate experience for all California community college students by pursuing policies that will improve student access and success while engaging and empowering local student leaders and honoring equity and diversity. Informed by resolutions adopted at the annual General Assembly and in consultation with the board and Legislative Affairs Committee, the SSSCC developed the following priorities for the 2025 legislative year.

EQUITY

We believe all students deserve the power to shape their education and futures, especially those from historically marginalized communities. Equity means ensuring undocumented, underrepresented, and disabled students have true representation, resources, and a real seat at the table in decisions that impact them.

No student should have to choose between their education and survival. Addressing housing insecurity, food access, and health care is essential for students to thrive. Meeting these needs is not an extra—it is the foundation for academic success.
